We are now in the process of launching an online learning app called Seesaw. Seesaw is an online resource that will allow us to communicate with children, set activities, share videos and respond to pupils work more effectively.

Seesaw has secure access and all children will be set an individual log in code. If we have your email address on record, you should receive an email containing your child's log in code and a 'Guide to using Seesaw' on or before Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June. If you have not received a code by then, we do not have an email address on file for you. For log in details, please send your child's name and their class to the relevant home learning email account or ring the school office.

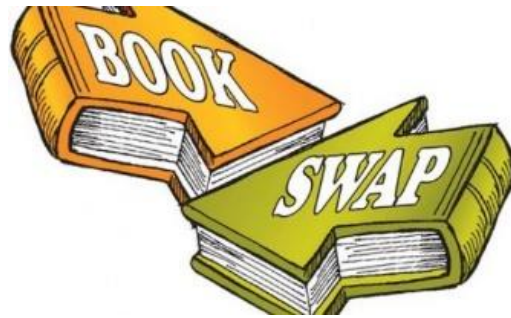
