Please drop them off at the school office if you can.

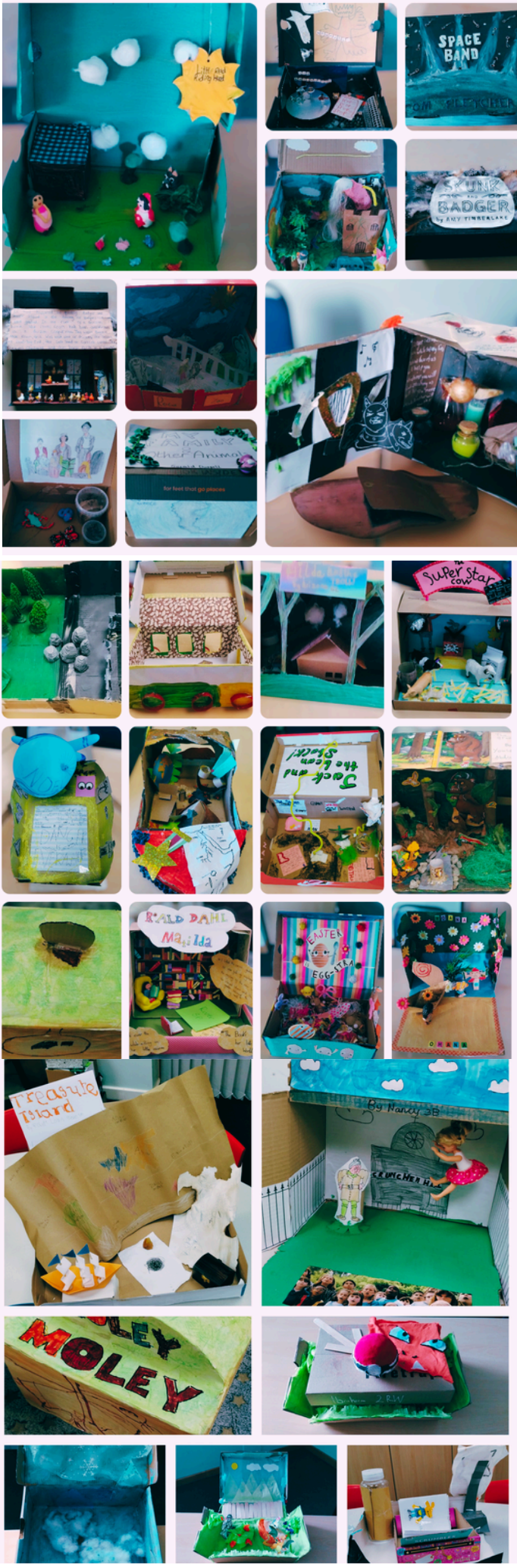
